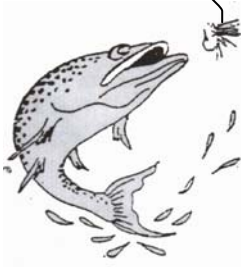

Peter Murray reported on items raised at the recent GACA meeting.


The Doctor Mitchell Shield is to be hosted by the Stratford & District Angling Club this year, and the base for the event will be the Stratford Angling Club's facility at Holland's Landing.

The GACA is looking for endorsement from other clubs to raise the legal size limit of Luderick. This was discussed and it was agreed that due to social reasons the legal limit for Luderick should be raised. John Utan put forward the motion that the legal size limit of Luderick be raised from 22 cm to be equal to the size limit for Luderick that has been adopted by N.S.W., John's motion was second by Peter Neligan and carried unanimously by the members.

An Olive Deceiver (Lefty's Deceiver).



Hook : Stainless # 4
Thread : Green
Wing : 6 to 12 white saddle hackles with an olive dyed grizzly feather on both sides. Add about 4 to 6 strands of pearl Crystal Flash to each side.
Collar : White bucktail
Beard : Red bucktail
Topping : 5 to 8 strands of peacock herl
Head : Green
Eyes : Optional
