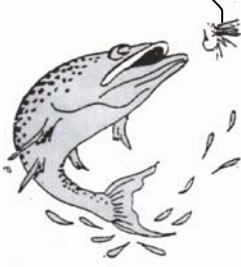

Hopefully you all are looking forward to this evening, it's a great night to relax and enjoy, hope to catch up with you on the night.

**Fish Reports**

John and Shannon Valentine reported catching 13 fish on the Licola club trip, and on another trip up to the Macalister River with Tony Wallace they caught 2 Browns and 2 Rainbows.

James Tourtoulas fished 20 Acer Creek and caught 2 small Rainbows.

Tony Dawkins landed 3 small fish in the Macalister River; he also noticed that there was an abundance of food in the water.

Stewart Batchelor was able to get away to Jindabyne to fish the Thredbo with Rick Sunderland just after opening weekend, Stewie caught 6 fish up to 1½ lb, and Rick caught 10 fish

Max Simmons managed a few fish on the bunk house trip, he also reported fishing Merrimans creek and caught and released several fish.

Peter Neligan reported catching 20 fish one afternoon on the fishing trip, the following weekend he caught fish to 40 cm at 20 Acre Creek. Peter also fished the Mitta Mitta River and caught 2 fish to 2¾ lb.

Peter Murray fished the Macalister River for 4 fish, 3 fin clipped Rainbows and 1 Brown

Mick O'Brien has had a bit of time off work and was able to fish on several occasions, he reported the following: Wellington River fished 3 times for 12 Browns 27 – 30 cm, Macalister River 4 times for 3 fin clipped Rainbows ( Right ventral) and 9 Browns to 30 cm + Mick said that the he was pleased with the quantity and the quality of the fish so far this season, it is a pleasant surprise, hopefully if we continue to get good flows and a mild summer the fish that are there now are in good conditions so thing should only get better.

**The Fly to Tie for the October 2004 Meeting is:**  
Winged Brown Ant of your own Choice

I have searched though the books that I have for ant fly patterns and there are several different types. Rob Flower's "Australian Trout Food, Trout Flies and How to fish them" has a couple of black ant patterns that you could modify to Brown on Page 84 – 85.

Generally most have descriptions but there are not many pictures that could be scanned and reproduced for the newsletter.

As this fly is to be of your own choice, I shouldn't influence you in any way. This is my way out of putting a picture and a description in the newsletter for you to copy off.

Generally, the patterns I have seen are hackle points tied in as wings, a couple of bumps built up on a small hook using tying thread, then finished off with some hackle wound in front. This is a very simple fly to tie, so give it a try.

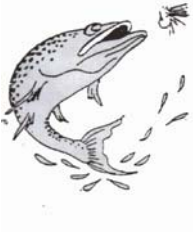

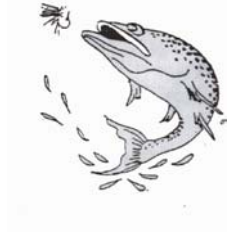
