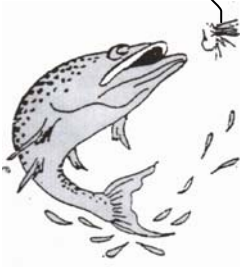

Michael O'Brien informed us that we now have a new DVD in our Video collection titled Salt Water Fly Fishing. Also Ray Warner has donated a lot of Fly Fishing and Fly Tying books to the Club, Michael said that he will have them catalogued and they will be available to be borrowed from the Club Library soon.

waters. The DSE believe that these frogs are being wiped out because of trout eating most of their tadpoles. Terry said that there had been a follow up article to this in the Weekly Times and that he would send it in or bring it with him to the next meeting.
