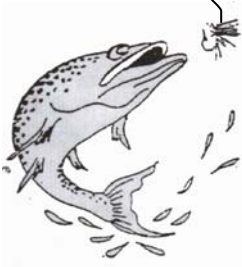

I mentioned that I had been contacted by someone from Gippsland Water Watch and he said that he would like members of our club to attend the Carp Fishing competition at Lake Guthridge in Sale on 27<sup>th</sup> November.

### Fish Reports

Neil Morrison & Noel Barnaby attended the Inaugural Lions Fishing Competition at Mallacoota. Neil said that they had a great time and won the competition.

Peter Neligan fished Jindabyne and Thredbo and brought 8 fish to 4lbs home.

John Utan had been fishing at a few locations and caught 11 fish to 30cm from the Indi, 6 fish to 32cm out of the Narial, 3 to 35cm from the Gibbo and 3 out of the Tyers River to 31cm.

Jack Groenewald fished the Macalister River and caught fish to 26cm

James Tourtoulas also fished the Macalister River and caught 1 Brown to 31cm and two other small Rainbows.

I went to the Tyers River with Mick and caught 6 small Browns to 32cm

Mick had a few fishing trips over the last month, 3 times fished the Macalister River for 5 fish to 28cm, Tyers River on 2 occasions for 14 fish and also caught a 3lb Rainbow from the Golf Course impoundment.

The Mylar Spider



Hook: Dry/wet standard or 1x Heavy # 14-12  
Thread: 6/0 Black or Brown  
Tail: Red Hackle Fibres  
Body: Rear ½ Holographic Silver Tinsel  
Front ½ Peacock Heal  
Rib: (Optional) Fine Silver Wire  
Hackle: Brown Hen or Partridge, 2-3 turns  
Note: For the rear body section substitute materials may be used, e.g. Pearl Mylar or flat silver tinsel
