Dave Holder suggested that the club could hold an Auction; this had been done at other clubs and was very successful. It was though that this could be included for 2006.

Jack Groenewald has found a successful method of attaching different boots to waders; this is with the use of the blue glue that is use for joining PVC pipe. To learn more about this method contact Jack at our next meeting.

Fish Reports

Jack Groenewald fished the Macalister river and caught a 25cm Rainbow

James Tourtoulas fished the Macalister River and caught 2 Rainbows to 25cm

Ron Bassler fished the Livingston for 3 fish to ¾lb, and the next day he saw 3 snakes in the same area

Dave Holder reported catching 3 Rainbows to 27cm from fishing the Macalister River

John Utan fished the Corryong area and caught 3 fish out of the swampy to 34cm and another 3 smaller fish out of the Narial Creek. John also had a trip to Western Australia and fished Harvey Dam, 140klm south of Perth; he caught 4 Rainbows at 1lb in 3 hours of fishing and said there where plenty of fish being caught by others

Ian Brideson caught 6 fish at Licola and a 1.0kg fish below the wall, and on another trip to Licola he caught another 2 Rainbows

Dean Cousin fished the Timbarra and caught 4 fish to 380g

Ian Brideson reported that Rick Sunderland had caught 13 fish at Jindabyne to 4lbs and that Rick had also made it to the Australian Championships in Tasmania. Congratulation Rick (Maybe you could send us a report on the Championships thanks Rick)

Guest Speaker:

Errol Parmigiani is the Regional Manager for the Department of Primary Industry, he spoke on trout stocking in this area, due to low water in the Western District some of the trout stocking for that area had to be redirected into other impoundments, so they have put a lot more fish into Blue Rock Dam, Errol said that it has been fishing very well with good catches of trout being recorded.

Errol said that they have been thinking of putting larger trout into the Macalister next year if it gets approved by fisheries Victoria.

Mostly Errol answered questions from the members who attended.

Hook: Size 10 - 12

Thread: Black

Tail: Small bunch of black cock hackle equalling hook length

Back: A strip of black Crow wing or substitute, doubled over lengthways and reaching almost halfway down the sides of the fly, tied by the tip and end

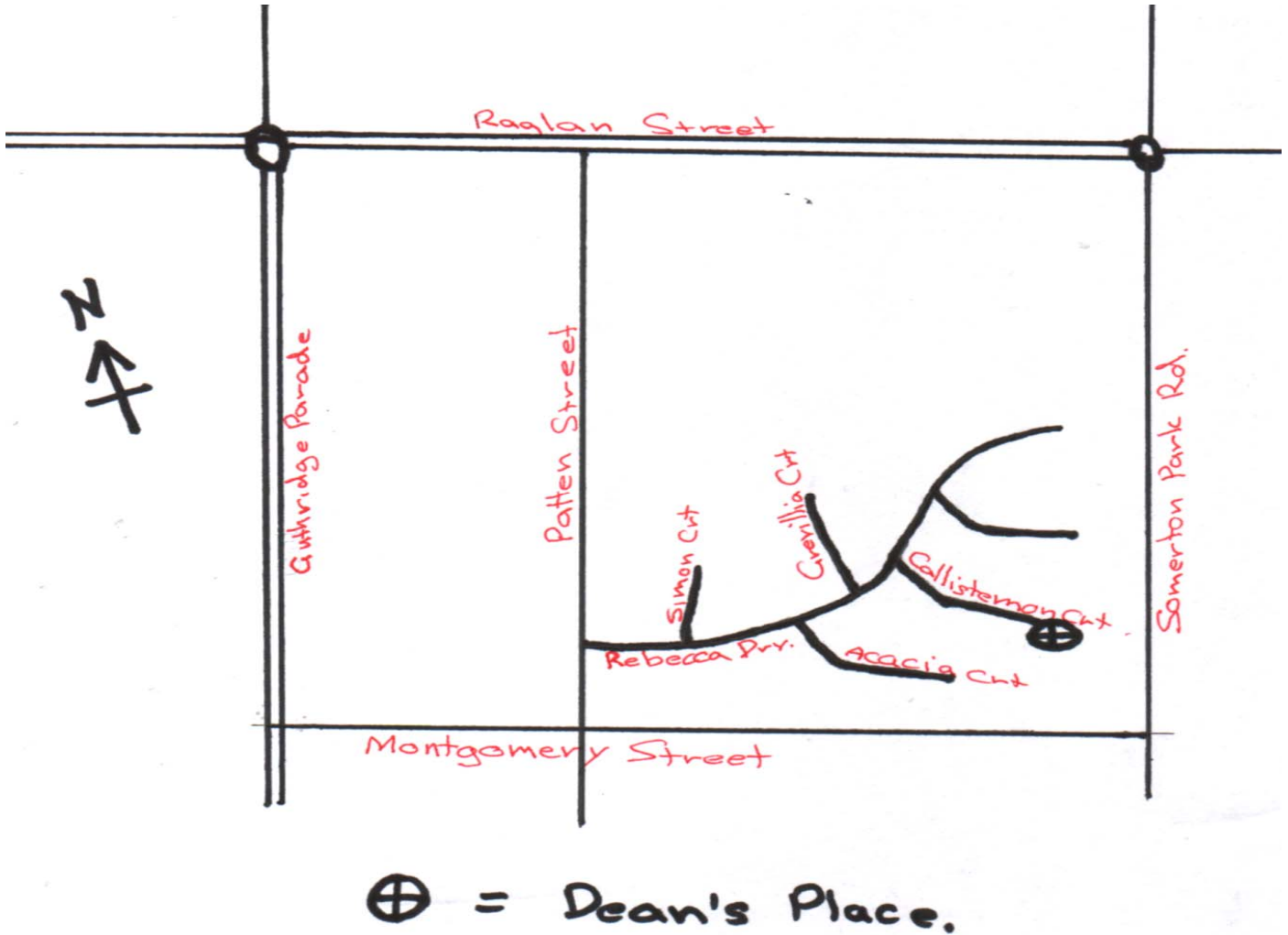
Body: Closely wound clear plastic simulating segmentation

Hackle: Two turns of black cock, the fibres equalling the shank length (Leave full, not gathered underneath into a throat style)

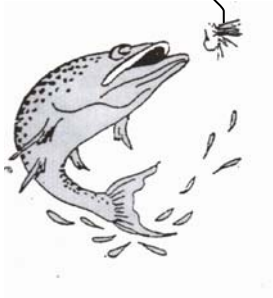

	Country Members	\$15.00 per anum

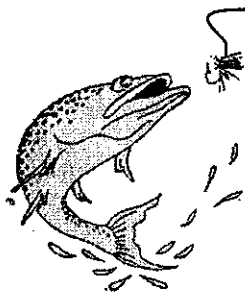
Committee Meeting: - Ray Clissold suggested that he would have to hold a committee meeting early in the New Year. A date will soon be set for this and all committee members will be notified.
