Tuna to 20lbs, Barramundi to 10lbs, Mangrove Jack to 50cm and grey Mackerel to 10lbs, Peter had lots of pictures on hand to show us of his trip. He said that Andrew Martin and he will do a guest speakers spot when they have everything ready.

Mick O'Brien has had a recent trip to the Gold Coast where he caught 12 flathead in the estuaries. He also fished the Macalister River recently and caught a 32cm brown trout.

Steve Jordan was over in WA recently and he reported catching lots of Salmon and Tommy Ruff. Victorian Fisheries have just completed their Small Waters Stocking Program for Central Gippsland just before the mid year school holidays, four of the small waters that were stocked with Rainbow Trout in this area were Hyland Lake at Churchill with 1000 fish, Kernot Lake in Morwell with 200 fish, Racecourse Reserve at Heyfield with 200 fish and 250 were released into Lake Guyatt here in sale. These fish were all about 25cm long and weighed around 170 grams. When release they were a little confused at first in the muddied water, but it did not take them long before these fish were out in the middle rising. It is hoped that many school kids take advantage of this during the winter break.
