### Committee Meeting:

The Committee members met recently and the following topics were discussed.

- ✚ Club Finances have been dwindling over the past few years, we are spending more than our income and one of the reasons is the cost of our annual dinner so this year we will be making the following changes, The club will not be supplying alcohol (BYO wine) and we will be cutting back \$100 on the amount that is spent on raffle prizes.
- ✚ The weigh book currently states that any fish entered must be weighed, Mick proposed an amendment to this due to a lot of our members practicing catch and release. This is to be amended to read "Weigh masters Judgement" if a fish is clearly the biggest eg. Photo evidence or witness is provided, then the fish does not have to be weighed, however if there are two fish of similar size, the one that is weighed will be the winner of that category. Mick is currently writing this up properly and it will be published when complete.

## General Business

Membership is down and we need to promote our club a bit more. Mick is to keep up the articles in the paper and possibly put in an advertisement on a few occasions throughout the year. Ray and Neil will be putting together a brochure that can be placed in the Sale Angler and may be handed out with fishing licences etc.

It was also thought that we could ask Andy & Kath if we could have a Brag Board located in their shop where current photos and information about our club could be placed.

Our saltwater trip to the Bemm will be on the 7, 8 & 9<sup>th</sup> of July.
