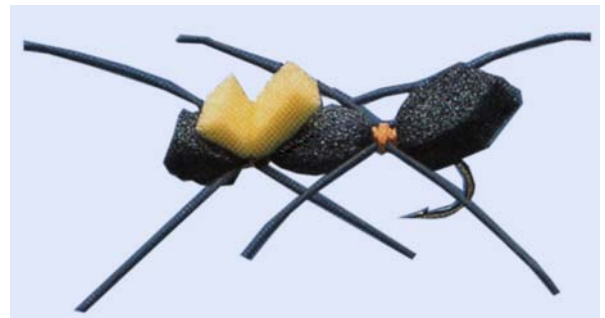
Pink Thing

Thread - 3/0 burnt orange monocord
Body - Black closed cell foam
Legs - Black med. Size rubber legs
Indicator - Yellow closed cell foam
