The Fly to Tie for the July 2007 Meeting is:
Glades Deceiver
(Salt Water Fly Patterns Page 32)

This pattern is tied as a deceiver and is rarely tied longer than 3 inches and in this picture a weedguard has been added.



THREAD: Black
WING: Two matched pairs of wide grizzly neck hackles placed so they flare inward, then add four to six strands of pearl Crystal Flash on each side
COLLAR: White bucktail, with a silver pheasant feather cheek, and six strands of peacock herl as topping
HEAD: Black eye painted yellow with black pupil
