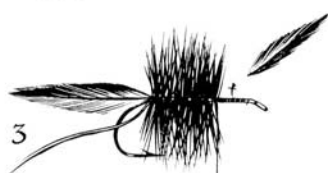

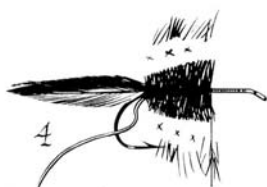
1
tie in 3 hackle tips to form tail - shiny sides on the outside



2
tie in gold wire, tie in hackle by the butt



3
wind hackle forward to form dense closely packed body



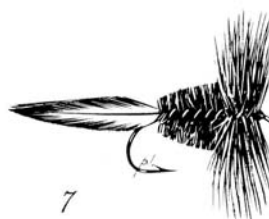

trim body to this shape

wind gold wire through hackle



6
tie in 2 hackle feathers by the butt



7
wind them both forward, trim, whip finish and varnish head.

Hook : 8 – 10 to imitate both male & female

Thread: Black

Tail: Three furnace hackle tips

Body: Three long black hackles, palmered and trimmed

Ribbing: Fine gold wire

Hackle: Two Furnace hackle
