TREAD: Fluoro pink flat waxed nylon

EYES: Spirit River 1-Balz, gold or black

TAIL: Light gold Tiewell Fly Fur

BODY: Pearl Mylar over which is clear V-Rib, with hot orange band of thread behind eyes

WING: Light gold Tiewell Fly Furover which is four strands of root beer Krystal Flash

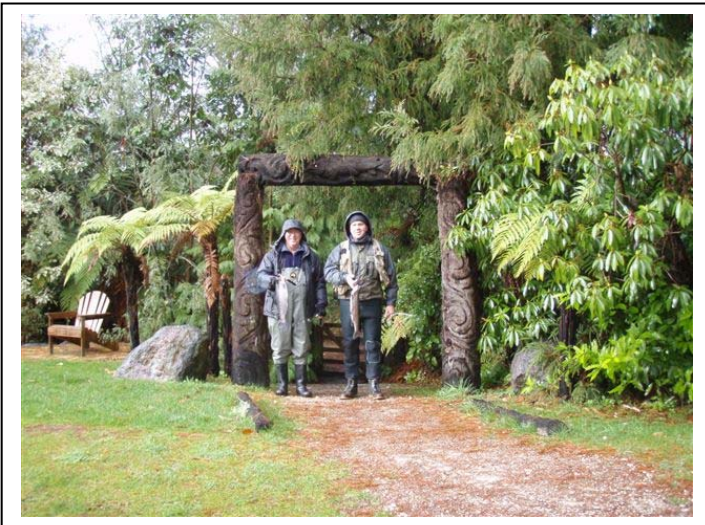

TRIP TO THE TONGARIRO RIVER, New Zealand

On the 18th of July, Steve Allen, his father Rob and myself made another trip to New Zealand. This year we stayed at Creel Lodge which is on the banks of the Tongariro at Turangi which is on the southern part of Lake Taupo. This area is just a dream for fly fishermen.

We found it wasn't too crowded, no trouble at all to get good places to fish. We found that the Tongariro had suffered from the biggest flood in one hundred years only a couple of weeks before we arrived and it rained quite a lot while we were there, however, the fish were still there.

The first day the Tongariro was running hard and dirty so we fished the Tauranga Taupo (the T.T. as it is called) a smaller river but still running a banker, and caught none. We probably should have fished the Tongariro as some old codger caught a fifteen-pound brown only a hundred yards from our accommodation.

He was wet lining and that was my downfall for the whole trip as I used this method for almost all the trip, while I had moderate success with yellow rabbits, red rabbits, black rabbits, green rabbits. (Guess what the big brown was caught on)

Steve fished really well using floating line, indicators, tungsten bead nymphs, egg pattern flies, split shot, you just had to get deep. Really hard fishing but he persisted and ended up getting quite a few fish between four and five pounds. He lost a really good fish that decided back in the lake was the place to be. Rob also lost a very good fish in the Tongariro. He wouldn't stop jumping, a great fighter.

We tried the Hinemaiaia, not so much water and clear, but more fishermen and caught no fish.

On the last day we fished the T.T. again and with a slight change of leader length, Rob caught the best fish of the trip, a rainbow of between six and six and a half pounds, a great fish. So I begrudgingly went back to floating line, egg fly and all the stuff and within five minutes had a rainbow of five to five and a half pounds, which was my best fish.

All together it was a great trip, great company, a lot of fun, and yes we are already booked in for next year. Can't wait till that comes.

Note: All fish listed, unless otherwise stated are Trout, either Brown or Rainbow and generally the majority of those fish over the 3lb mark would be Browns.

It should also be noted that I have hardly mentioned catches in the Upper and Lower Macalister River, the Wellington River, Shaws Creek or the Barkly River. These would amount to hundreds of fish over the last 20 years and this report would be a lot longer. The general range of fish caught would be stocked Rainbows ranging from 20cms to 35cms and natural Browns from 10cms to 44cms with a few larger fish caught in the Lower Macalister and Glenmaggie Weir.
