The Fly to Tie for the September 2009 Meeting is:

SEPTEMBER:

Split Partridge

(The Complete Guide to New Zealand Trout Lures – Page 58 & 200)

HOOK: 2-8

TAIL: Yellow hackle fibres

BODY: Orange chenille

RIB: Oval silver tinsel

WING: Split partridge tail

HEAD: Black

Tie in the tail whisks. Tie in the chenille and the ribbing. Wind on the chenille back nearly to the head. Split a partridge tail feather in half down the spine. This provides two matching sides, which are then tied in at the butt. Wind on the ribbing, tying down the wing (Matuka Style) to the top of the body. Tie in the hackle feather, and wind on to form the hackle collar.
