Colour scheme optional

Hook – Standard SS #4-1/0

Thread – Size & colour to match

Tail – 4 strands rubber legs, 6-8 strands krystal flash

Body – Chrystal chenille

Wing – Natural or synthetic hair topped with a few strands krystal flash

Eyes – Dumbell or bead chain

Legs – 1 strand rubber each side
