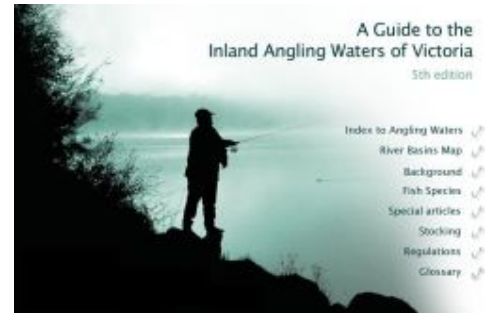

## Anglers have a new guiding light to inland waters

Victorian anglers have long been familiar with the Guide to Inland Angling Waters of Victoria which was first written and published in 1976.

A new online version of the Guide has been released at [www.dpi.vic.gov.au/angling](http://www.dpi.vic.gov.au/angling). The new version uses modern technology with a key feature being interactive maps for many of the key angling waters.



For more than 30 years the various editions of this guide have answered questions such as 'where can I go fishing?', 'what am I likely to catch?', and 'how do I get there?', for thousands of beginner and seasoned anglers.

The previous online version was developed in 2002 and much has changed in the last eight years. Drought conditions have seen some waters become temporarily unsuitable for stocking whilst many new waters have been found and developed as part of the Family Fishing Lakes Program.

The online Guide will be updated regularly to provide information on stocking and inform anglers to any changes to water conditions or access. It will also incorporate the classification of inland waters, which is currently being prepared to provide a key resource for anglers.

The new online guide is one of a range of initiatives to improve fishing through the Victorian Government's \$13.5 million Enhanced Recreational Fishing Program. The Guide's information has been sourced from the personal and professional knowledge of many fishing enthusiasts who have spent much of their lives on the water undertaking research, surveying and stocking fish, patrolling, fishing and talking with other anglers.

The new guide has been thoroughly revised to reflect the current condition and management of Victorian inland waters and contains many new photographs and illustrations.

Another great feature is the inclusion of web links to current water storage levels for many of the large impoundments which are important fisheries.
